2019 Legislative Action Request (LAR) Forms are Now Available

As the dust settles from the 2018 General Assembly session and the members of the legislature prepare for the elections in the fall, MML is now accepting requests for legislative priorities for the 2019 legislative session. The deadline for submission is Friday, July 27, 2018. To submit a legislative request, please complete the form, which can be found here: [2019 LAR Form](#). Remember that each municipality, chapter, or department is limited to up to three legislative requests and each LAR must be verified and signed by a representative of the municipality, Chapter, or Department prior to submission showing each LAR was approved/endorsed at a meeting of the jurisdiction submitting the LAR. Instructions for submission are included on the LAR form.

The Maryland Sustainable Growth Awards celebrate significant achievement by individuals, businesses, organizations and local governments to support the [12 planning visions](#) adopted by the Maryland General Assembly. Awards are given in the categories of Leadership and Service, Sustainable Communities and Preservation/Conservation. They will be presented at the 2019 Sustainable Growth Awards Ceremony next year.
