- Agree to visit one another's municipality, at least once, preferably during a council or department meeting.
- Establish a timeline of monthly communication (i.e. email, phone calls or coordinating to meet during various MML activities/meetings).
- Agree to meet at either the MML summer convention or fall conference.
- Provide feedback to MML via periodic evaluation emails and a year-end evaluation.

If you believe that you can fulfill these requirements, we invite you to join our pool of mentors and mentees.
